Law Enforcement and Community Relations

11. Community Policing

- a) Adopt definition - January 1, 2021 and formally added to Policy Manual shortly thereafter.
- b) Team for community policing and engagement - Established and ongoing. In the last three years, NHF&G's LE Division has become proactive in engaging community relations (public agencies, non-profit partners, community/constituent based programs, educational facilities) via a dedicated LE social media page (FaceBook) as well as PSA's and press releases. Our social media posts alone for the LE Division reach over 200,000 people per month. In addition, the NHF&G Department shares the above on the official Department social media pages as well as the Dept. website reaching even more people in and out of state.
- c) Ongoing training – July 2021. We will collaborate and partner with NH PSTC and NH State Police to achieve standardized and consistent training on the topic.

Recruitment for State Law Enforcement Agencies

14. Recruitment Team & Plan – December 1, 2020. We will have a plan in place and submitted by the deadline of 12/7/2020.
