PURPLE DAY – EPILEPSY AWARENESS DAY MARCH 26, 2021

WHEREAS, Purple Day is celebrated every March 26th in order to recognize Epilepsy Awareness Day; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 40 different forms of epilepsy, as well as 25 different types of seizures; and

WHEREAS, approximately 3 million Americans and 65 million people worldwide suffer from a form of epilepsy; and

WHEREAS, not all forms of epilepsy are treatable, but those that are require a combination of drug therapy and sometimes surgery; and

WHEREAS, Purple Day is a grassroots effort celebrated on all continents in over a dozen countries to spread awareness of this disease;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRISTOPHER T. SUNUNU, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim MARCH 26, 2021 as PURPLE DAY in honor of EPILEPSY AWARENESS DAY in the State of New Hampshire, and call this day to the attention of all citizens.
