

A state-of-the-art campus with housing, supportive services, and and respite/retreat beds for Veterans and their families

Overview:

• Working with the Legislature, the state will partner with Easterseals to develop a state-of-the-art campus in Franklin, New Hampshire, to provide mixed housing, supportive services, and retreat campus for veterans and their families. This 15-acre site includes transitional housing, permanent housing, and respite/retreat beds for veterans. The campus also contains amenities to assist in the health and wellness of residents and guests. The integration of care coordination and therapeutic and recreational services are pivotal to recovery.

Services:

• The envisioned services will include care coordination, home care services, transportation services and behavioral health services for mental health and substance misuse for veterans.

Amenities:

• The envisioned site amenities include a wide range of outdoor recreational opportunities, including challenge courses, equine therapy, pet therapy, a retreat/respite center, and access to a rail trail and watersports.

Estimated Cost:

• \$21 Million in ARPA funds

Estimated Timeline:

- Pre Development Phase: 6 months currently underway
- Development Phase: 4 months to commence upon approval of project funds
- Construction Phase: 12 months to commence upon completion of development phase
