Dear Commissioner Sheehan,

It has come to my attention that the State of New Hampshire does not provide funeral processions with an exemption from paying tolls on our Turnpike system.

Grieving individuals and families deserve to be able to travel on New Hampshire roadways unimpeded by our tolls as they pay their final respects. To that end, I have signed an Executive Order, effective immediately, to direct our toll attendants working in the cash lanes at our toll booths to waive the toll fare for participants in funeral processions.

The lead car in any funeral procession shall stop, identify themselves, and inform the toll attendant of how many vehicles are part of the procession. The toll attendant shall then permit however many vehicles are identified as participating in the procession to pass free of charge.
