GAS PRICES UP FROM JAN. 2021 TO JAN. 2022

VETOED COST INCREASES

Blocked TCI, a 17 cent per gallon gas tax

Vetoed a bailout for out-of-state energy generators

Stood against efforts to repeal RGGI ratepayer rebates



Stopped massive increases in subsidies to solar developers and lobbyists

STEP 1: \$7.5 MILLION to benefit 24,000 households enrolled in the Fuel Assistance Program



STEP 2: \$7 MILLION INCREASE TO \$20.5 MILLION

Electric Assistance Program discounts to those making less than 60% of the median household income



STEP 3: **\$60 MILLON Monthly Ratepayer Credit** Automatic Monthly Credit To NH Residential Ratepayers





\$100 Automatic Decrease to Residential Ratepayers No application or rebate process required
