WHEREAS, every year, approximately 40,000 babies are born in the United States with congenital heart defects; and

WHEREAS, some congenital heart defects are not diagnosed until months or years after birth; and

WHEREAS, undiagnosed congenital heart conditions may cause sudden cardiac death in young athletes, and early diagnoses and routine screenings are essential for good health; and

WHEREAS, Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week provides a special opportunity to recognize families whose lives have been affected by this ailment, honor dedicated health professionals, and raise public awareness about congenital heart defects;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRISTOPHER T. SUNUNU, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim FEBRUARY 7-14, 2020 as CONGENITAL HEART DEFECT AWARENESS WEEK in the State of New Hampshire and call this to the attention of all citizens.
