## EXHIBIT Z to Emergency Order #29

## N.H. Office of Professional Licensure and Certification, April 14, 2021

Pursuant to Emergency Order #29, which authorizes temporary modification of executive branch deadlines and other requirements, issued pursuant to Section 18 of Executive Order 2020-04 as modified and extended by Emergency Orders 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-14, 2020-15, 2020-16, 2020-17, 2020-18, 2020-20, 2020-21, 2020-23, 2020-24, 2020-25, 2021-01, 2021-02, 2021-04, and 2021-05, the following is hereby ordered:

1. The administrative rules of the New Hampshire Board of Dental Examiners currently require applicants for licensure as a dentist or dental hygienist pass an examination that includes clinical procedure components performed on a patient. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, many previously qualifying examinations no longer include performing clinical procedure components on patients. Accordingly, the requirements in administrative rule are amended as follows: notwithstanding the definition of "clinical" in administrative rule Den 101.06, all applicants for licensure as a dentist or dental hygienist may complete the clinical procedure examination requirements mandated by Den 301.0l(a)(S)(b) or Den 301.02(a)(8)(b) on either a live patient or on a mannequin. This amendment shall be in effect until the State of Emergency expires or is terminated.
