only market sector with state guarantee to not close their doors

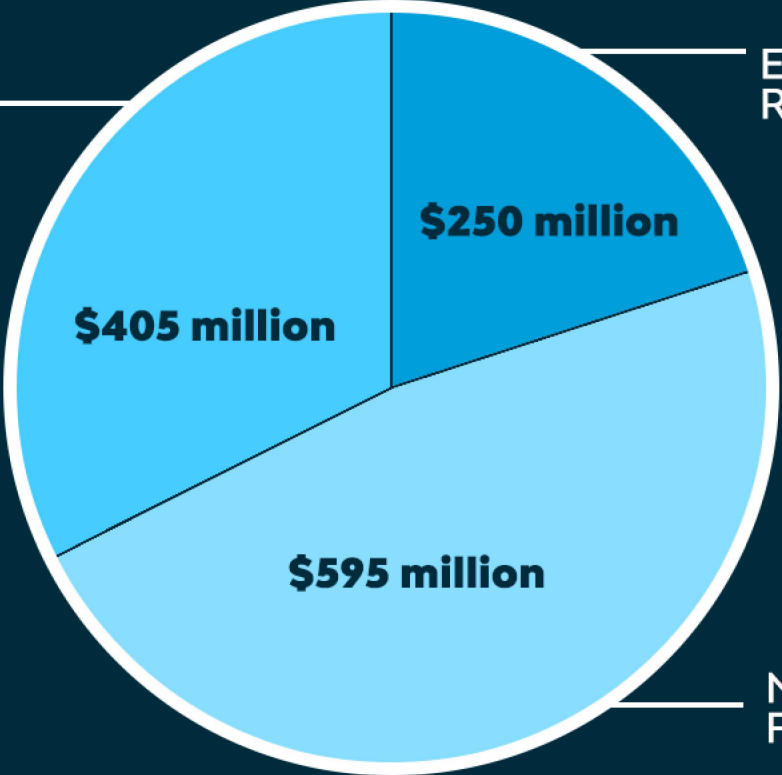
