A Proclamation

In the year of our Lord Two Thousand and Twenty

KOREAN AMERICAN DAY
FEBRUARY 8, 2020

WHEREAS, January 1903 marked the beginning days of Korean immigration to the United States, as well as the start of a national Korean-American movement; and

WHEREAS, the descendants of these original Korean immigrants have enriched the culture of the United States and of New Hampshire; and

WHEREAS, the Korean-American Society of New Hampshire, under the tireless leadership of Sun Woo Park, has provided guidance and assistance to many Koreans in our state; and

WHEREAS, services such as that performed by the Korean-American Society of New Hampshire are important to help many people discover their cultural or ethnic heritage; and

WHEREAS, there are more than two million people within the Korean-American community today making important contributions to our country as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRISTOPHER T. SUNUNU, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim **FEBRUARY 8, 2020** as **KOREAN AMERICAN DAY** in the State of New Hampshire and call this day to the attention of all citizens.
