LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL WEEK
MAY 9-15, 2021

WHEREAS, the week of May 15th each year is proclaimed by law as Law Enforcement Memorial Week, in honor of the federal, state, and municipal officers who have been killed or disabled in the line of duty, and of those still serving; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers exemplify the most time-honored American ideals of public service and sacrifice, protecting the citizens of our state; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers are highly trained and dedicated individuals who demonstrate daily an extraordinary caliber of character and courage; and

WHEREAS, without the expectation of recognition or applause, these brave men and women routinely risk their own lives in unpredictable and volatile situations to ensure the safety of their communities and fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, we are all indebted to these brave individuals who sacrifice each and every day for the greater good of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRISTOPHER T. SUNUNU, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim **MAY 9-15, 2021** as **LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL WEEK** in the State of New Hampshire and honor those who have sacrificed their lives for our safety, and thank law enforcement officers across the State for their unyielding dedication and heroism.
