WHEREAS, the New England Patriots beat the Los Angeles Rams by a final score of 13-3 to win Super Bowl LIII, making this the lowest scoring Super Bowl game ever, a testament to the outstanding defense played on both sides; and

WHEREAS, the New England Patriots had another amazing season with a 11-5 winning record, winning the AFC East division for the tenth year in a row; and

WHEREAS, the New England Patriots are the league's first team to win division titles in 15 of the last 16 years; and

WHEREAS, Julian Edelman, the Patriots star wide receiver, carried the game with a high of 10 catches for 141 yards, taking the Most Valuable Player honors with the support of an unrelenting defensive line; and

WHEREAS, Tom Brady appeared in his record setting ninth Super Bowl game and has the most wins of any quarterback with six wins. He currently holds ten Super Bowl records including most passing yards for his career and per game, most pass completions for his career and per game, and most passes without an interception per game: and

WHEREAS, the New England Patriots continue to set a high standard of excellence in the National Football League, and continually distinguish themselves as one of the greatest teams of all time;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRISTOPHER T. SUNUNU, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim the week of FEBRUARY 4th as **NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS APPRECIATION WEEK** in the State of New Hampshire, and I urge all citizens to join me in congratulating the **NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS** on another outstanding season.
