Dear Attorney General MacDonald:

Thank you for your letter dated May 8, 2020 regarding your recommendation of approval of the following grant applications under the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program:

- 1.) Application from the Manchester Fire Department for \$78,041.12 to provide two mobile emergency medical technicians to assist in the prevention, preparation, and response of the spread of COVID-19 within Manchester homeless encampments.
- 2.) Application from the Concord Fire Department for \$56,418.85 to purchase three ventilators for its ambulances, personal protective equipment (PPE), and supplies for a temporary quarantine shelter for Fire Department personnel.
- 3.) Application from the Town of Hudson for \$34,598.91 for overtime for Fire Department personnel incurred in response to activating the Town's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and for decontamination and disinfecting supplies.
- 4.) Application from the Wolfeboro Police Department for \$23,864.60 for overtime costs due to extra shifts needed for increased tourism traffic in the downtown area, incurred overtime for the set-up of an Alternative Care Site, hazardous duty pay for non-sworn personnel, and disinfecting supplies for the police station and cruisers.
- 5.) Application from the Keene Fire Department for \$84,130.01 to purchase ventilators and IV pumps for its three ambulances along with PPE for first responders.
- 6.) Application from the Bedford Fire Department for \$87,600.98 to purchase ventilators for its ambulance, a UV disinfecting machine for fire apparatus, and an emergency portable shelter.
- 7.) Application from the New Hampshire Liquor Commission, Enforcement Division for \$99,868.00 for reimbursement of PPE supplies for all of its investigators.
- 8.) Application from the 45th Parallel Emergency Medical Services for \$52,442.72 to purchase four ventilators for its ambulance fleet along with the associated equipment.
- 9.) Application from the Hooksett Fire Department for \$58,736.00 for overtime staffing to operate an additional ambulance, along with PPE and sanitizing supplies.

Based on your recommendations and the information you submitted to my Office through your letter, and pursuant to my authority under Executive Order 2020-04 and RSAs 4:45, 4:47, and 21-P:43, I hereby approve the above grant applications for a total of \$575,701.49.

I extend my sincere thanks to you and your team for your work on these grant management efforts.
