EXPLANATION

1.) Is the travel required by law, court order or some other mandate? If yes, explain.

The Forest Protection Bureau to sends resources on assignments out of state for wildfire and all-hazard emergencies. Every year the Forest Protection Bureau supports the national need for wildland firefighters through the Master Agreement (Stafford This Act) with the USFS. This agreement supports resource movement from NH to other areas of the country as well as into NH during emergencies here.

2. If more then one person is included in this request, explain the need or requirement for the additional person(s) traveling in addition to the one.

Throughout the year there are multiple assignments in which we send resources. Some assignments are for single resources (1 person with a special function) while other assignments are for multiple people or equipment (such as a 20 person hand crew).

- All funds are reimbursed per the Master Agreement with the USFS.
- 4. How does the acceptance or denial of this request affect services provided?

Acceptance of the request will allow us to continue our support of the national emergency system put in place for handling large scale disasters. A denial of this request will mean that NH does not assist other areas of the country during emergencies.
