EXPLANATION

The Nongame Biological Aide is a seasonal position that we hire annually to assist with various project needs within the Nongame Program. During 2020, work includes conducting surveys, research, and captive rearing for state endangered White Mountain fritillary butterfly. Position will be primarily based at Mount Washington. Funding for position is 100% federal revenue.

Standard Questions:

1. What services or constituency group will be affected if this position is not filled?

Work under this project is in cooperation with the USFWS in implementing actions for White Mountain fritillary, a species proposed for federal Endangered Species Act. Our actions are intended to benefit the species overall status and to be used for federal review of species status. Research results will also guide actions of NH State Parks, Appalachian Mountain Club, and the Mount Washington Auto Road.

2. Are the services/duties performed by this position required by law, rule, court order or some other mandate? If yes, explain.

RSA 212-A gives authority and responsibility for endangered species recovery to NH Fish and Game. USFWS is providing 100% of funds for this work.

3. Did the position become vacant because of a promotion or personnel action within the organization, or did the incumbent move to another state position? Define

NA. 'This is a seasonal position. The position has been filled seasonally in previous years and was scheduled to begin May 8, 2020. Position was posted and interviews were conducted prior to hiring freeze.

4. Can other personnel within the department cover the duties of this position? Explain in detail

No. Position will be located at Mount Washington. All NHFG Nongame full-time staff are stationed in Concord and regular transportation to Mt. Washington is not feasible. Even when this position is filled, work duties have required participation of a full time biologist that coordinates activities. Field and laboratory duites require regular presence that other Department staff don't have capacity for.

This is a seasonal position.
