EXPLANATION

The Piping Plover and Upland Sandpiper Biological Aide is a seasonal part-time position (29.5 hrs/week) that we hire annually to assist with two endangered species conservation projects. Work includes monitoring coastal beaches for nesting piping plovers, setting up protective exclosures around nests, and educating people to ensure the safety of the birds. Also includes identifying state endangered upland sandpiper nests on Pease airport base so that regular mowing can occur for airport safety and not impact endangered species. Funding for position is a combination of dedicated accounts and federal revenue.

Standard Questions:

1. What services or constituency group will be affected if this position is not filled?

Work under this project is in cooperation with the USFWS in implementing necessary federal recovery plan actions for Piping Plovers. Monitoring and protecting nests is a requirement under federal ESA. If NHFG didn't do this work, NH State Parks and Towns would be required to conduct work in compliance with USFWS ESA. Pease airport base depends on our monitoring efforts for upland sandpipers so that they can maintain airport safety by mowing fields while not impacting state protected endangered species.

2. Are the services/duties performed by this position required by law, rule, court order or some other mandate? If yes, explain.

RSA 212-A gives authority and responsibility for endangered species recovery to NH Fish and Game. Duties performed by this position also implements federal Endangered Species Act recovery plan actions and agreements with State Parks and Pease Airport Base. Section 6 of the USFWS ESA requires collaboration with state wildlife agencies and provides the necessary federal funds for this position.

3. Did the position become vacant because of a promotion or personnel action within the organization, or did the incumbent move to another state position? Define

This is a seasonal part-time (29.5 hrs/week) position. The position has been filled seasonally in previous years and was scheduled to begin April 10, 2020.

4. Can other personnel within the department cover the duties of this position? Explain in detail

No. Even when this position is filled, work duties have required participation of a full time biologist that coordinates activities. Monitoring requires regular presence that other Department staff don't have capacity for. Because duties require 7 days/week coverage at times, multiple staff are needed to cover during critical times.

5. Can the duties be completed by a part-time position? Explain in detail

Yes - this is a part-time position

6. If this position has been vacant for a period of time, explain how the work previously done by this position has been allocated to, or covered by others during this vacancy period.

This position is vacant during the winter annually. Work duties for this position begin during spring each year.
