## EXPLANATION

Temporary part-time Biological Aides are needed to conduct marine recreational fishing surveys and supporting seasonal field work for federal projects that F\&G Marine Division is obligated to conduct by federal grant or MOA.

This position is needed to maintain project deadlines that increase on a seasonal basis. Federal aid projects and associated MOA work will not be fulfilled without this part-time seasonal position. Without data collection efforts during seasonal periods this will affect stock assessments, fishery managment decisions, and ultimately affecting the recreational and commercial fisheries in NH .
