In the year of our Lord Two Thousand and Twenty Two

**LYME DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH**  
**MAY 2022**

**WHEREAS**, it is estimated that up to 476,000 people may get Lyme disease each year in the United States: and

**WHEREAS**, Lyme disease occurrence has been steadily on the rise across the nation, and New Hampshire had the third-highest incidence rate in 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, 46% of NH residents say they are at a low or no risk of contracting the disease, 2% of residents report having Lyme disease at the time of a recent survey, and 20% of people reported incorrect removal methods; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Hampshire and Tick Free NH and it's council have partnered together to raise awareness around Lyme Disease and encourage residents to protect themselves from tick bites, inspect themselves, children, pets, and properly remove any tick found; and

**WHEREAS**, raising awareness of the risks, prevention methods, removal and symptoms are key to reducing the incidence of Lyme disease in our communities;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRISTOPHER T. SUNUNU, GOVERNOR** of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim **MAY 2022** as **LYME DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH** in the State of New Hampshire, and call this to the attention of all citizens.
